

## Sustainable travel

Nordic Music Days would like to mitigate climate impact and encourage everyone travelling to the festival to consider ways to reduce carbon footprint where possible. We appreciate that we are working across island nations and rural areas where overland routes are not possible and that participants may have care and work responsibilities that prevent longer travel time away from home and families. We will be discussing these kind of challenges in our industry programme this year – why not join the debate?

Ways we have thought about supporting you to ‘travel green’ include:

- Longer travel stays: Programming a conference and industry programme alongside the artistic programme, to provide more than one way to participate in the festival and to make the overall travel stay longer.
- Overland travel: Providing information on alternative travel routes
- Flights: Recommending direct routes and ‘group travel’ – more people travelling on the same flight where possible.

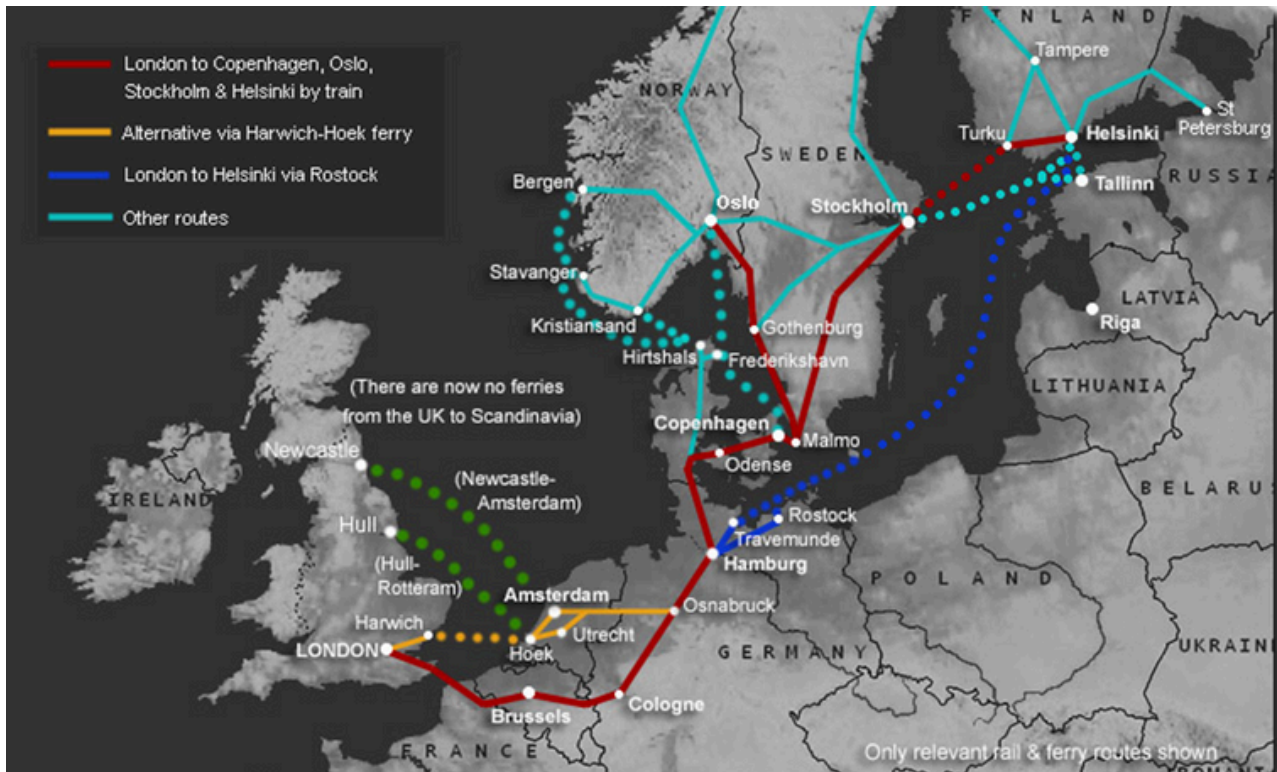
Arrivals into Glasgow:

- By train: Glasgow Queen Street and Glasgow Central Station are within 5 – 10minutes walking distance of the recommended hotel and 5 – 20 minutes walking distance from most Festival venues
- By bus: Buchanan Street Bus Station is 2minutes walk to the recommended hotel
- From Glasgow airport: [Glasgow Airport Express 500](#), operates a 24 hour service with a journey time of 15minutes. Tickets (£17 return) can be bought in advance or on the bus. Arrives Buchanan Street Bus Station.
- From Edinburgh airport: [Citylink AIR Glasgow 900](#), operates a 24 hour service with a journey time of 50minutes, tickets (£26.50 return), can be bought in advance or on the bus. Arrives Buchanan Street Bus Station.

Getting around Glasgow:

Glasgow has one of the world’s oldest [subway systems](#), fondly known as ‘The Clockwork Orange’, as its colour scheme is orange and it runs in a clockwise and anti-clockwise loop! See the venues section for the nearest subway stops.

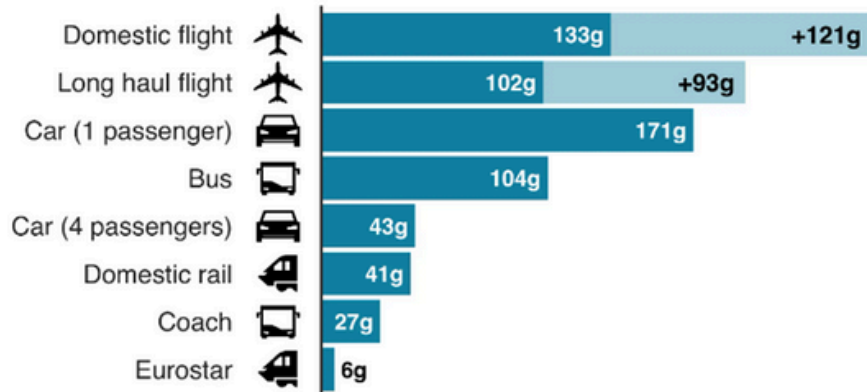

# Denmark

## Travel options

- **Flight:** Direct flight Copenhagen to Edinburgh with Norwegian/Easyjet, bus Edinburgh to Glasgow Bus Station – Mon/ Tue/ Wed out, only Fri/Sat/ Mon return
- **Flight:** Aarhus to Glasgow, via London with Ryanair/Easyjet/BA, bus to Glasgow
- **Train:** Copenhagen to Glasgow, overnight on the sleeper London to Glasgow
- **Bus:** Flix Bus, Copenhagen to Glasgow, overnight on the bus

- **Flight:** Direct flight Helsinki to Edinburgh with Finnair, bus Edinburgh to Glasgow Bus Station – only Mon/ Wed/Fri out, Thu/ Fri/ Sun/ Mon return
- **Flight:** Helsinki to Glasgow, via Amsterdam with KLM, bus to Glasgow
- **Ferry/Train:** Helsinki to Glasgow with ferry to Stockholm, then route as from Stockholm
- **Bus:** Flix Bus, Helsinki to Glasgow, two overnights on bus
- **From Kirkenes:** Flight to Oslo, then routes from Oslo
